BOND GROUP – WORKING TO PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT

The shortage of natural materials and the release of harmful Chloro Fluoro Carbons (CFC) into the atmosphere from leaking refrigeration and cabinet insulation breakdown, is causing a problem of global proportions, say the experts.

However, working to protect this environment is The Bond Group – one of Europe's leading chiller and refrigeration companies – who were one of the first to embrace new legislation to regulate and monitor the safe disposal of refrigeration equipment.

In legislation passed in 2001 it became lawful for companies to ensure that materials used within the construction of cabinets, including copper, steel and aluminium are recycled.

The Group therefore, formed a Cabinet Disposal Division, which offers a complete end-of-life cabinet service. Every cabinet disposed of is logged and an appropriate destruction certificate is issued to confirm that all criteria have been safely met.

Working closely with Government Advisory Bodies and legislators such as DEFRA, the Division has met and exceeded all criteria.

For their efforts, The Bond Group recently won the Environmental Initiative of the Year Award, for their pioneering work in case recycling and disposal.

A spokesman said: "We offer a peace of mind service to ensure that when our customers wish to dispose of their redundant equipment, every process is carried out with 'due diligence'".
